10.a. Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) and Budget Update (LCAP Goals: #1, #2, #3, Governance)

Minutes:

Will Lucey reported to the Board the LCAP and Budget updates from the October 17, 2018 Board Work Study meeting. Highlighted updates that Mr. Lucey shared included:

1) Parent Survey Response Rate was 23%. Although considered a good response rate from Panorama, we will be looking to improve this rate significantly.

2) Targets will be set for Reclassification Rate and ELPAC progress towards proficiency when results of the Spring 2018 Summative Test are reported.

3) 2018-2019 Targets with regards SBAC ELA and Math need to be looked at and adjusted so that they are realistic and attainable especially with the sub groups.

4) Students Survey has been given recently and results should be coming out soon.

5) Chronic Absenteeism 18-19 Targets need to be adjusted due to actual 17-18 outcomes being better than targets set.

6) We will be looking at actions and strategies in all three goals to improve student achievement for students who are English learners, socioeconomically disadvantaged or have a disability.

10.b. Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Local Indicators (LCAP Goals: #1, #2, #3)

Minutes:

The Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) is a tool for local educational agencies to set goals, plan actions, and leverage resources to meet those goals to improve student outcomes. Pacifica School District Board of Education Trustees approved the 2018 LCAP at the June 13, 2018 Board Meeting.

The state monitors school districts' progress through the California Dashboard that is also accessible to the public at large. Broken into two focus areas of State Indicators and Local Indicators the presentation will review the evaluation rubric and focus on the Pacifica School District Local Indicators for the Trustees review, insights, and input.

The PowerPoint attached to this agenda item outlines the indicators and the progress the District has made.

Board questions/comments included: Percentage of participation in the survey; and do the results of the survey include comparative district. Will Lucey indicated that although the participation percentage was 24%, Panorama stated that percentage rate is considered very good. Mr. Lucey is looking at ways to improve that percentage in the future. Mr. Lucey also shared that Panorama is looking into reporting normed results for similar sized school districts.
