OFFICIAL NOTICE OF THE PACIFCA SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING THE PARCEL TAX SENIOR EXEMPTION

An exemption from the school district's parcel tax is available to eligible senior citizens who reside in property they own within the boundary of the school district, as follows: "In order to provide tax relief to senior citizens in the community, any parcel owned and occupied by a person 65 years of age or older shall be exempt from the Save the Pacifica Schools Act of 2008. Upon proper application to the District" property owners who previously qualified for the senior exemption are required to renew their eligibility annually, by June 30, if they wish to continue to receive the exemption in the upcoming fiscal year. A renewal form will be mailed approximately April 1, 2011 to all property owners who qualify for the exemption for the current fiscal year. Property owners who wish to apply for the 2011-12 fiscal year must complete and return the form to the Pacifica School District Office of Fiscal Services at 375 Reina Del Mar, Pacifica CA 94044.
