SUBJECT: Parcel Tax Oversight Committee Annual Report

(Information)

The Measure N Parcel Tax and Renewal (Measure L) (Save Pacifica Schools Act) ballot language stated that the Parcel Tax would have "independent citizen oversight". In the fall of 2008, the Pacifica Board of Trustees established a committee to review expenditures and to report to the public regarding the match of expenditures to the ballot language. The Committee consists of six parents (one from each school site selected by the Parent Teacher Organization) and seven community members (selected through an application process by the Governing Board). Pacifica School District Parcel Tax Oversight Committee Report – January 2018

The parcel tax oversight committee, community members and parent representatives, have been charged to review the parcel tax ballot language and review expenditures of these precious taxpayer funds. The responsibility of this committee is to determine if the expenditures of parcel tax funds have been spent in accordance of the ballot language.

This group of community members and parent representatives met on Oct. 17, 2017 to review the expenditures of parcel tax funds for 2016-17 fiscal year as well as to review proposed expenditure for 2017-18 fiscal year.

The committee reviewed the parcel tax ballot language. The Chief Business Officer presented a summary of expenditures and projected expenses backed up with detailed financial records. The Superintendent presented student achievement as assessed by state testing. The district is improving each year and using data to adjust expenditures that support improvement in student learning.

The committee asked questions regarding the expenditures. At the end of the discussion, the committee determined that the Pacifica School District has spent precious tax payer dollars to ensure that the district:

- Attract and Retain teachers by funding teacher positions and provide new teachers with support to be the very best.
- Support struggling students by funding counseling and teacher training to meet the needs of every student.
- Engage students in science by sending all 5th graders to Outdoor Education for one week where they receive a real world experience in science. The expenditures for gardens continues to support this one week experience at each school where the goal is to develop students as stewards of our community.
- Support libraries and technology by funding library technicians who support teachers to provide access to information both through books and internet.

In 2016-17 fiscal year, revenues were higher than expected and expenditures were lower, as a result, there were one time funds available. The Pacifica School District Board of Trustees spent these one time funds to buy library books and provide math summer school program. These expenditures are not in the 2017-18 projected budget. The district spent one time money for summer math program to show that a success that could be leverage for future grant funds.

While the committee feels that the precious tax dollars are being spent in accordance with the ballot language including struggling students, there was a question about how the district can provide an environment to challenge students to go to the next level.
