NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pacifica School District hereby gives notice that a public hearing will be held as follows:

Pacifica School District Board of Trustees is holding a public hearing to solicit the recommendations and comments of the public regarding the specific actions and expenditures proposed to be included in the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) or annual update of the LCAP.

TOPIC OF HEARING:

The Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) is designed to close the achievement gap by providing additional funds to support improved student outcomes and accountability. We must develop a plan locally that achieves improved results. The LCFF accountability system requires that districts develop a three-year Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) and annually update it.
